<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5%: Central Research Fund</li> <li>• 10%: Research Subsidy Administration</li> <li>• 40%: Research Reserve Account</li> <li>• 25%: Authors</li> <li>• 20%: Faculty/Unit</li> <li>• No cash payment to authors</li> <li>• Fund are paid into authors' research cost codes, to be used for research-related expenses</li> <li>• On retirement, resignation or death, funds revert to faculty/unit</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Small equipment less than R25 000 not provided by department or faculty</li> <li>• Any piece of a tangible asset that has a life expectancy of generally more than one year and which is not consumed in the normal course of the research project.</li> <li>• Field work travel per km @CPU rates</li> <li>• Accommodation (3-star or less) if site of data collection is more than 100km both ways from campus of operation @ CPU rates</li> <li>• Daily subsistence @ CPU rates</li> <li>• International study visits, workshops and conferences</li> <li>• Remuneration for research assistants (see Guidelines)</li> <li>• Local conferences: registration, travel, accommodation</li> <li>• Proofreading and editing of manuscripts for publication in DHET accredited journals</li> <li>• Subscriptions to professional bodies</li> <li>• Textbooks, books and journal subscriptions</li> <li>• Non-standard computers and computer software specific to a research project, Internet vouchers</li> <li>• Personal computers, laptops, printers</li> <li>• Printing and binding of staff dissertations/theses</li> <li>• Page fees for journal publications in non-accredited journals. (Page fees for journal publications in accredited journals are paid from the faculties' allocation of the DHET publications subsidy.)</li> </ul>
